Partner with us and earn an income to ensure the survival of the native plants and animals on your land.

The **Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT)** provides annual payments to eligible landholders through our Conservation Management Program. This funding allows you to diversify your income while protecting NSW's unique biodiversity.

Eligibility for this program depends on your property's location, size, and the condition of flora and fauna. Visit our website or contact us using the information on the bottom of this page to learn more.

You can partner with us by entering into a conservation agreement under either our conservation tenders or fixed price offers. Conservation agreements under this program are registered **on the land title**, which means that the area will be protected

even when your property is sold or passed on (and the annual payments will be made to the new owner).

Conservation Tenders

Landholders in tender areas can submit a bid to receive annual payments for conservation. Tenders are opened periodically throughout the year in different areas of NSW. Applicants are assessed on a value-for-money-basis.

Fixed Price Offers

Landholders in our identified priority areas can apply to receive annual funding at a fixed price (\$/per hectare/year) for conservation. Applications are assessed up to twice a year, on a value-for-money basis.
