Partner with us to protect the biodiversity on your land and enable it to thrive, now and into the future.

Do you have areas of your property with unique biodiversity that you would like to conserve?

The Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT), provides an opportunity to enter into an agreement that will protect habitat for native plants and animals on your property.

Eligibility for this program depends on your property's size, and the type and condition of flora and fauna.

This program has two agreement types:

Conservation Agreements

In-perpetuity and registered on the land title for protection into the future. Any new owners must continue managing the land for conservation.

Wildlife Refuges*

Recorded on the land title and transferred to subsequent landholders. Can be revoked by the landholder at any time.

**Interested landholders may be encouraged to consider the Land for Wildlife program as an alternative.*

Once you have an agreement under this program, you can apply for a Conservation Partners Grant, to assist with the management of your conservation area. Examples of grant-supported actions include fencing, pest and weed control, habitat restoration and revegetation.

Grant funding ranges from \$2,000 to \$15,000 per year for up to three years. Higher levels of funding are only available for in-perpetuity Conservation Agreements.
