Entry-level partnerships with grant funding available for conservation actions.

Partnership conservation agreements

On title, in-perpetuity partnerships with grant funding available for conservation actions.

Conservation partners

Up to \$15,000 a year for up

Funded conservation agreements

On-title, in-perpetuity or fixed term agreements with annual conservation management funding for landholders in **eligible areas**.

Annual payments from the BCT for BCT priority areas

An agreed, ongoing conservation management payment for conservation actions - for the term of the agreement.

Time to prepare agreement.

Site remains protected in-perpetuity, even when the property is sold or passed on.

Time to prepare agreement.

Financial support for conservation actions through conservation partners grants.

Site remains protected in-perpetuity or for a fixed term, even when the property is sold or passed

Financial support for conservation actions through annual payments.

Biodiversity stewardship agreements

On title, in-perpetuity funded agreements for landholders wishing to generate and sell biodiversity credits under the Biodiversity Offsets Scheme.

Income from selling biodiversity credits generated through the agreement.

Annual payments from the BCT to undertake conservation actions.

Up-front costs for assessment of land by Accredited Assessor, and additional application costs.

Generation of biodiversity credits that can be sold for profit.

Site remains protected and funded in-perpetuity, even when the property is sold.

Financial support for conservation actions through annual payments.

What technical support is available?

- Access to landholder support staff and ecologists for technical advice, assistance and practical support
- Connection to a network of other landholders in your region
- Invitations to BCT workshops and other events
- Links to natural resource management agencies or groups such as your local LLS or Landcare
