Fixed Price Offers

The Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT) is inviting expressions of interest (EOIs) to participate in the BCT fixed price offers. See the BCT fixed price offers webpage for details about the next EOI assessment https://www.bct.nsw.gov.au/fixed-price-offers.

Important information for landholders

Submitting an Expression of Interest (EOI) is the first step to take if you are interested in participating in the BCT fixed price offer.

When an EOI assessment takes place, the BCT will prioritise EOIs for site assessment with the highest-ranking sites offered a site visit. Following the site visit, the BCT will confirm eligibility to participate in the fixed price offer and the values of your site will be quantified. Accepting a site visit does not commit you to participating in the program.

To be eligible, proposed sites must be in the eligible area (refer to fixed price offer maps) and contain:

Central - Eastern NSW

- a minimum of 50ha of native vegetation that supports threatened species habitat: or
- a minimum of 20ha of a Threatened Ecological Community (TEC); or
- an important wetland shown on the Directory of Important Wetlands of Australia, including Ramsar wetlands.

Western NSW (Western Land Division)

- a minimum of 500ha native vegetation that supports threatened species habitat; or
- a minimum of 20ha of Threatened Ecological Community (TEC), or
- an important wetland shown on the Directory of Important Wetlands of Australia, including Ramsar wetlands

BCT staff will confirm the presence and condition of these conservation assets if you are prioritised for a site assessment. The conservation assets must be in moderate to good condition.

A separate expression of interest is required for each property¹ or for each parcel of land that is owned by separate legal entities. The BCT reserves the right to limit site assessments for properties owned by the same legal entity.

³ Under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act* 2016 an 'owner' of land includes: (a) every person who, either at law or in equity: (i) is entitled to the land for any estate of freehold in possession, or (ii) is a person to whom the Crown has lawfully contracted to sell the land under the *Crown Land Management Act* 2016 or any other Act relating to the alienation of lands of the Crown, or (iii) is entitled to receive, or is in receipt of, or if the land were let to a tenant would be entitled to receive, the rents and profits in respect of the land, whether as beneficial owner, trustee, mortgagee in possession or otherwise, and (b) a person who leases land under the *Crown Land Management Act* 2016, and (c) any other person who, under the regulations, is taken to be the owner of the land, but (unless the regulations otherwise provide) does not include a beneficiary of a trust relating to the land.
