Use this form to apply to sell biodiversity credits to the BCT.

Information on the biodiversity credits open fixed price offer (Open FPO) can be found in the <u>participant guide</u> (the Guide) on the BCT's website.

Who can apply?

The Open FPO is available to:

- owners of credits created under the current Biodiversity Offsets Scheme (termed BAM credits); or
- owners of credits created under the former BioBanking Scheme (termed BBAM credits) and have obtained a <u>statement of reasonable credit equivalence</u> to determine the equivalent number of BAM credits; or
- landholders who are interested in establishing a biodiversity stewardship agreement (BSA) and have obtained either a <u>feasibility assessment</u>, or a <u>business case</u> from an accredited assessor, or have applied for a BSA.

Applicants must have a GST registered ABN to proceed with a credit sale.

BCT staff and Board members (and their close family members) are not eligible to apply.
