Darling Baaka conservation tender

Interested in receiving **funding for conservation**? If you live or own land along the Darling Baaka corridor from the Bourke-Brewarrina LGA boundary south to Wentworth, you could be eligible for the Darling Baaka conservation tender. Successful applicants will enter a conservation agreement and earn annual payments to protect native vegetation.

In these sessions we will provide information on how the tender works, eligibility, important details about conservation agreements, as well as a general overview of the BCT and how we work with landholders. We will also discuss other current BCT opportunities. You will meet your local BCT staff and discover opportunities designed to help you protect your local area for generations to come.
